Polo

- Primary/Grades K, 1, 2 Royal Blue or White
- Intermediate/Grades 3, 4, 5 Teal or White
- Middle School/Grade 6, 7, 8 Black or White

Dri-Fit Tshirt

- Primary/Grades K, 1, 2 Royal Blue, Dark Gray, Light Gray
- Intermediate/Grades 3, 4, 5 Lime, Dark Gray, Light Gray
- Middle School/Grade 6, 7, 8 Black, Dark Gray, Light Gray

Uniform Bottoms - May be purchased anywhere

- Boys –Shorts or pants in khaki, navy, black; four pockets or less; neatly tailored style. No cargos, blue jeans, athletic slicks or sweats; no rips.
- Girls Shorts, skorts or pants in khaki, navy, black. Shorts or skorts length near the knee. No blue jeans, leggings, athletic slicks or sweats; no rips.

Socks/Shoes/Accessories

Closed-toed, closed-heel shoes worn with socks. No crocs, sandals, skate shoes, boots. No extremes in jewelry, makeup or hairstyles. Hats and bandanas are not permitted.

Cool/Cold Weather Clothing

- A solid black, blue or gray buttoned/zipped sweater or hoodie may be worn. (Must be SOLID color; no patterns, large logos, graphics, etc.)
- Students may purchase a GSOTA hoodie from Harris School Uniforms.

Dress Down Days

Clothing on dress down days must conform to standards of propriety reflected in the school uniform. No offensive images or text, immodest cuts or fits, spaghetti straps or other attire deemed inappropriate by administration.

Uniform Violations

School administrators will determine if clothing is appropriate for school and complies with the dress code. If a student comes to school out of uniform (or dressed inappropriately on dress down days), the parent will be called to immediately bring the student a change of clothing. Habitual or excessive violations of the dress code will result in additional consequences.
